WELLBEING SYSTEM TRIAL

As part of the schools Wellbeing policy we will be trialling a new system for those students who receive level notes to help ensure parents/carers are aware of their child's behaviour. Currently students who are placed on levels receive detentions varying from 1 to 3 days in length;

Orange 1 detention, Purple 2 detentions, Red 3 detentions.

Under the proposed new system an additional 2 days would be added to each level;


Orange 3 detentions, Purple 4 detentions, Red 5 detentions.

Under the proposed new system an additional 2 days would be added to each level;

Orange 3 detentions, Purple 4 detentions, Red 5 detentions.

Under the new system students will have the opportunity to reduce the number of days they are on detention by doing two simple things;

- 1. return the signed level note to the class teacher which will reduce the number of detentions by 1 day.
- 2. ensure they behave appropriately during their time in detention which will also reduce the number of detentions by an additional day.

Provided students can complete these two simple tasks the number of detentions they will be required to complete under the new system will be exactly the same as the current system.

We will begin trialling this system from Monday 16th November and run through until the end of the 2015 school year.

What To Say To Encourage Resilient Behaviour:


- You didn't let yourself get too upset, well done.
