
Pocket in Iolanthe Street, South Grafton (near Bunnings) where they will embroider the school logo for \$5.00.

These handy Lunch wallets will allow you to place your Lunch order in clear zippered pocket and keep the change zipped safe and away from food.


They fold down and fasten closed into a convenient wallet when not in use.

Cost will be \$10.50 per bag.




