#### Online bullying and misuse of social media

Dear families, over recent weeks there has been many notifications and incidents where students have been involved in online gaming and bullying. This is a serious concern in our community and is negatively impacting our students wellbeing at school.

**The school is:** providing specific lessons on cyber safety and correct use of technology through specialised ICT Lessons and general in class lessons. These lessons are in line with the e-safety commission.

#### What you can do:

Monitor their use and accounts (parent locks are available).

#### Ask questions

Asking questions about how they feel and what they know helps you to gauge your child's level of knowledge and keeps you from lecturing.

For example, you could ask:

- 'Have you seen anyone being bullied online? How did you think that made them feel? How did you feel? Has anything like this ever happened to you?'
- 'Is cyberbullying a problem at your school?'
