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












In mathematics we have been learning about fractions and time. We have learnt that fractions are equal size parts and can be shared evenly between groups. Students have solved problems involving quarters, halves and eighths. We have also used what we have learnt about fractions to assist our understanding on analogue clocks (quarter to, quarter past and half past). We have made clocks to assist in our understanding of the relationship between these terms and their corresponding minutes (e.g. quarter past is 15 minutes).
